Dr. Algundgi's recently introduced innovative concept of "Homeo Gurukul" is a jewel in the Swara crown . The sharing of knowledge in the picturesque Konkan's eco-friendly environment in the lap of nature, has taken the homoeopathic world by storm. The idea of imparting in a classroom pattern but in the natural open surroundings has been warmly welcomed globally. The Gurukul teaching is conducted in a setting respecting traditions, to impart the fundamentals of Homoeopathy while making way for sharing the latest contemporary advancements- the best of both worlds.
